

# Friends of Wompatuck Meeting 8/21/17

**Meeting opens 7:00 PM**

**VP Report:** Lars Ahlzen reviews map updates. He's added the 2017 Landmine route and made the map even more utile.

**Secretary's Report:** Bill Boles' minutes are reviewed and accepted

**Treasurer's Report:** Doug Luoma discusses insurance savings and pump track expenses. Treasurer's Report accepted.

**Membership Chair Report:** Sandy Cole reported that we have two new members bringing us up to 186 families.

**Pump Track:** Mark Schow reports that the Pump Track is done. It's been hydro seeded and as it's being used a lot. Brad Sands notes, that any future improvements should be run by him.

**Landmine Classic:** There will be a final planning meeting at Bike Barn on 8/25 @ 7:00 PM.

**Gammon Bridge:** Tim Friedman reports that the bridge was constructed in one day by 25 Volunteers and big assists from DCR staff.

**Landmine Classic:** 9/10/17: Vicki Schow Reports that there will be a pre-event work party on Saturday 9/3 starting at 7:00 AM. Pre-Arrowing will be done and there will be a volunteer party.

**Motion:** Expend \$300 to pay for the party. Passed Unanimously.

Signs have been created and posted in surrounding neighborhoods and on the kiosks.

**Motion:** Purchase a Friends of Wompatuck tent that can be used at the Landmine and other events for \$800. Motion passes unanimously.

Dirtwire or other video companies to create a 5-minute Landmine Video that can be used for future promotions. Motion: Expend up to \$1500 on this project. Motion passes unanimously.

Alex Hall notes that A DCR escort or advanced notice to Brad Sands is the norm for "behind the gate" projects.

For this Landmine, there will be no paint on the roads, instead there will be removable arrows.

**Brad Sands:** It was noted that Brad Sands' position as park supervisor is now permanent. A spontaneous round of applause for Brad follows.
