1, Officers Reports

Suggestions: Put a trash barrel near the pump track. * Brad Sands will handle that.

Possibility of putting an observation platform near the head of the track that people could sit on and parents could use to watch their kids. – Will be explored.

Bike repair stand: - Tim reported the results of his research. Three stands were reviewed. After much discussion one was chosen. **Motion** – To authorize the expenditure of up to \$2000 to purchase and install the stand provided it gets a DCR okay. Vote **Unanimous**.

Future projects – South Field improvements, Union Street "sidewalk" at the choke point.

Next Trail Care Day will be on 11/5 or 11/12. Possible projects include Pitcher Pond Bridge repairs and trail clearing.
